PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS,** historic vehicles rekindle memories which serve as a common bond for all who have served our great country in peace and in conflict; and
- WHEREAS,** many of these military vehicles represent the American motor vehicle industry's finest and most durable products, made here in Indiana and built to take the rigors and punishment of any environment in the world; and
- WHEREAS,** those that restore these vehicles do so with great attention to detail, respect, and devotion, often refurbishing parts no longer produced by resurrecting old skills and craftsmanship; and
- WHEREAS,** those that maintain these retired vehicles often display them in patriotic events, ceremonies, and parades that afford Hoosiers an opportunity to experience and appreciate them as well; and
- WHEREAS,** it is appropriate to recognize the historic military vehicle and those that restore, maintain, and display an essential component of Indiana's rich military heritage;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim September 12-18, 2011 as
